SUBJECT: EXCLUDING SPECIFIC CATEGORIES OF NON-ARMY MANAGED ITEMS FROM THE SINGLE STOCK FUND

1. FOLLOWING A COMPREHENSIVE REVIEW OF NON-ARMY MANAGED ITEMS (NAMI), THE SINGLE STOCK FUND (SSF) EXECUTIVE STEERING COMMITTEE (ESC) HAS APPROVED THE GENERAL OFFICER WORKING GROUP (GOWG) RECOMMENDATION TO EXCLUDE SPECIFIC NAMI THAT ARE NOT SUPPORTED BY THE STANDARD ARMY RETAIL SUPPLY SYSTEM (SARSS) AND THE ARMY MATERIEL COMMAND INSTALLATION SUPPLY SYSTEM (AMCISS). SARSS- AND AMCISS-SUPPORTED NAMI INVENTORY WILL CONTINUE TO BE FINANCED BY THE ARMY WORKING CAPITAL FUND - SUPPLY MANAGEMENT ARMY (AWCF-SMA).
2. ACCORDINGLY, THE FOLLOWING INVENTORIES WILL NOT BE FINANCED BY THE AWCF-SMA AFTER 30 SEP 00:
 - A. CLASS I - SUBSISTENCE, SUPPORTED BY THE ARMY FOOD MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (AFMIS).
 - B. CLASS II - CLOTHING, SUPPORTED BY THE ARMY CLOTHING INITIAL ISSUE POINT SYSTEM (ACIIPS).
 - C. CLASS III - BULK PETROLEUM, SUPPORTED BY THE FUELS AUTOMATED SYSTEM (FAS).
 - D. CLASS IV - ENGINEER SUPPLIES, SUPPORTED BY THE INTEGRATED FACILITIES SYSTEM (IFS).
 - E. CLASS VIII - MEDICAL, SUPPORTED BY THE THEATER ARMY MEDICAL MANAGEMENT INFORMATION SYSTEM (TAMMIS).
3. PURCHASES OF ASSETS MANAGED IN THE EXCLUDED SYSTEMS SHOULD BE MADE WITH DIRECT CONSUMER FUNDS BY MAXIMIZING THE UTILIZATION OF PRIME VENDOR PROGRAMS, DIRECT VENDOR PURCHASES, AND DOD PURCHASE CARD PROGRAMS. SYSTEM PROPONENTS SHOULD BEGIN TO MAKE THE NECESSARY SYSTEM CHANGES/UPGRADES THAT WILL ALLOW THE DIRECT CITATION OF CONSUMER FUNDS. ADDITIONALLY, MACOM'S SHOULD BEGIN DIRECT CONSUMER FUNDING AS SOON AS THE NON-SARSS SUPPORTING SYSTEMS CHANGES ARE IN PLACE.
4. ATTRITION OF INVENTORIES MANAGED BY THESE SYSTEMS MUST BE COMPLETED AS FOLLOWS:
 - A. FOR THOSE AUTOMATED SYSTEMS HAVING AN IMPACT ON THE DEMONSTRATION SITES, THE PROPONENTS MUST PLAN TO HAVE STOCKS AND THE REQUISITIONS OUT OF AWCF-SMA 31 JAN 00.
 - B. FOR THOSE AUTOMATED SYSTEMS NOT INVOLVED IN THE DEMONSTRATION SITES, STOCKS AND REQUISITIONS MUST BE OUT OF AWCF-SMA NLT 31 JUL 00. THE OBJECTIVE IS TO MOVE THESE ITEMS OUT OF AWCF-SMA AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. OUR INTENT IS TO TRANSFER ANY AWCF-OWNED INVENTORIES REMAINING IN THESE SYSTEMS TO DEFENSE LOGISTICS AGENCY (DLA) ON 30 SEP 00.
5. THE SSF PROGRAM MANAGER IS CURRENTLY IN THE PROCESS OF

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COORDINATING WITH DLA TO TRANSFER CLASS II CLOTHING INVENTORIES TO THE DEFENSE WORKING CAPITAL FUND (DWCf) AND FORWARD STORE THESE ITEMS AT ARMY INSTALLATIONS. AFTER FURTHER EVALUATION, CLASS II RATIONS AND CLASS VIII MEDICAL ITEMS MAY ALSO BE CONSIDERED AS FORWARD STORED, DWCf FUNDED CANDIDATES. ADDITIONALLY, THE DLA FUELS AUTOMATED SYSTEM OF CLASS III - BULK POL IS MOVING FORWARD AT A FAST PACE. WHEN FULLY IMPLEMENTED, DLA WILL OWN ALL BULK POL INVENTORIES ON ARMY INSTALLATIONS.

6. THE EXCLUSION OF THE AFOREMENTIONED INVENTORIES WILL ELIMINATE INVENTORY MANAGEMENT REDUNDANCIES AND STREAMLINE FINANCIAL PROCESSES. DETAILED IMPLEMENTATION PROCEDURES WILL FOLLOW FROM ODCSLOG. WE NEED YOUR INVOLVEMENT AND SUPPORT TO MAKE THE TRANSITION A SMOOTH ONE.
